

House Rules

1. The house rights lie with the employees of the youth center and the employees commissioned by the city of Lindau. The regulations, rules and specifications of the employees of the youth center, as well as the commissioned staff, must be observed and followed by all persons who enter the building.
2. Our offers are aimed at young people and young adults from Lindau between the ages of 12 and 27.
3. The currently applicable Youth Protection Act must be observed:
 - Smoking is strictly forbidden in the youth center.
 - Bringing and consuming drinks containing brandy wine is prohibited at any age.
 - It is forbidden to bring and consume third-party alcoholic beverages. Anyone who meets the minimum age may hand in drinks to the specialists and will be given them back when they leave the facility.
 - The consumption of energy drinks in the youth center is only permitted from the age of 16.
4. It is strictly forbidden to bring, use and sell drugs that fall under the Narcotics Act. Finds are reported immediately and handed over to the police.
5. It is forbidden to bring weapons and weapon-like objects into the premises and on the grounds. They will be confiscated immediately and reported to the police.
6. Human freedom and dignity must not be despised. No symbols and labels may be used or disseminated which stand in spirit for anti-constitutional organizations or represent them. We treat each other with respect. Any form of verbal and non-verbal violence is prohibited. We reject any form of racism, xenophobia, and right-wing extremism.
7. The furnishings and inventory are to be treated with care. Anyone who willfully destroys these must be liable for the damage incurred.

8. Everyone disposes of their own rubbish in the house and on the premises. Bringing your own food is allowed under this condition. Unsolicited tidying up is taken for granted.

9. The rules of use posted for the MiniRamp must be observed. Before the first use, the user agreement must be signed by the legal guardian and handed in to a pedagogical specialist. Helmets are compulsory. In the event of disregard, we reserve the right to prohibit use.

10. Jackets and backpacks must be hung up in the designated cloakroom in the hallway. Valuables are to be kept in the youth center out of the reach of others. We accept no liability in the event of loss or damage.

11. The city of Lindau assumes no liability for any damage to yourself, others, or objects.

12. Visitors who use devices, tools and machines require the consent and instruction of the respective specialist on site.

13. No pornographic, violent and/or other youth-endangering sites may be accessed in our facility. In addition, downloading files is not permitted in our WLAN.

14. Listening to music should be at a volume at which normal conversation is still possible.

15. If the house rules are disregarded, the employees of the youth center and the assigned staff will make use of the right to ban the responsible person(s) from the house.
